### ***“The Eucharist, Communion with Christ and with One Another”***

The next International Eucharistic Congress will be held in Dublin, Ireland, from June 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012. The theme *“The Eucharist, Communion with Christ and with One Another”* was inspired by the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the inauguration of the Second Vatican Council. This theme refers to the Council’s Constitution *Lumen Gentium* which stated that: “Really partaking of the body of the Lord in the breaking of the Eucharistic bread, we are taken up into communion with Him and with one another.”

The theme of communion, proper to the 2012 International Eucharistic Congress, is at the heart of our identity and our mission, particularly in an era when basic changes are happening in communications and social relationships. In God’s plan, the Church is to be a sign and an instrument of uniting people with God and with one another.

Congress activities will be held in Croke Park Stadium, which has a capacity of 80,000 for the closing Mass. Weekday activities, such as workshops and special events, will take place at the Royal Dublin Society (RDS), similar to Quebec City’s Expocité.
